Public Hearing

Mayor Bob Dablow called for a motion to open the Public Hearing – County Road 67 Reconstruction

Council member Lloyd Helgeson moved that the Public Hearing be opened; Council member Drew Schwan seconded the motion. Mayor Bob Dablow opened the Public Hearing at 7:05 pm.:

Council Members present were Mayor Bob Dablow, Tom Berglind, Adam Jenstead, Lloyd Helgeson and Drew Schwan.

Others present were Wendy Otte/City Clerk, Dan Hanson, Mike Kurkowski, Rose Beck, Jim Mattingly and Claudia Mattingly.

City Engineer Dan Hanson Explained the project to those in attendance.

This is the final assessment hearing for the County 67 project. This project was initiated by the City Council, we held a public improvement hearing on April 17th and opened bids on July 16th.

The total cost of the project has gone down, but costs to the city have gone up \$11,000.00. Total cost of the project is \$268,622.00, the grant only covers the bid amount and the city incurs all other costs. There was an overage of asphalt used that the grant also does not cover, the city costs have gone up substantially since the project started, but the assessments have not been raised. \$599.06 per parcel is still the total assessed to the residents. The assessments can be paid in full to the city within the next 30 days or they will be assessed to the property taxes at 4% over the 5 year period they are assessed to property taxes. The parcels assessed are the properties in Quarterline Crossing as the project abuts that development.

A MOTION was made by Adam Jenstead to close the Public Hearing. Council member Drew Schwan seconded the motion. The public hearing closed at 7:27 pm.
